Visual Learning and Latin Language Acquisition

- Friday morning’s session will feature presentations by Darius Arya (Director of the American Institute for Roman Culture) and Steve Tuck (Professor of Classics, Miami University).
- The Vergilian Society luncheon speaker will be Michael Barich (Kenyon College).
- Friday’s afternoon session will feature presentations on using movies to teach Latin by K.C. Kless and Alex Fries (Indian Hill Schools), and on ODIP and Latin Language Acquisition by Jennifer Lehe (Columbus Museum of Art) and Elise Gursahaney (Columbus Academy). The afternoon session will also feature a presentation by Travis Horseman, author of a graphic novel set in late antiquity, *Amiculus*, and a panel of Ohio Classics professors and instructors on student recruitment from the HS and the college perspective.
- Friday’s banquet speaker will be Darius Arya.
- Saturday’s session includes presentations on the new ACL Standards by Sherwin Little (American Classical League) and on the new Caesar/Vergil AP course by Sarah Elmore (Lakota East). The Saturday session will also feature a Q&A session for students with Darius Arya.
