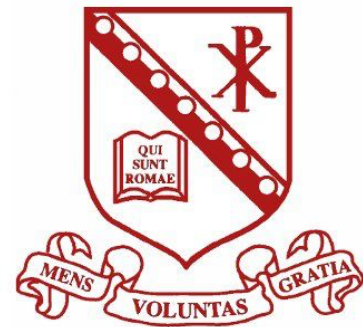


The Gabii Project and St. Stephen's School High School Internship in Archaeology

About the Gabii Project

We are an international archaeological team based out of the University of Michigan. We will be spending our 11th summer at the Latin city of Gabii studying the formation and growth of an ancient city-state that was both neighbor, and rival to, Rome in the first millennium BCE. Our work spans the Iron Age to Late Imperial Period, excavating both simple hut architecture and lavish public buildings.

What you will learn

- The archaeology of Rome and Latium, including guided trips to select sites and museums and off-site lectures by university professors
- Excavation and interpretation of ancient Gabii
- Digital, cutting edge recording techniques
- Scientific processes, including environmental and biological analysis
- Close work with small finds, like ceramic, metal, and much more!
