FOR OHIO TEACHERS OF CLASSICS

The Charles T. Murphy Foreign Study Scholarship for \$2,000.00 is being offered for a formal summer study program, such as the American Academy of Rome, The Vergilian Society (any tour conducted by the Society), or the American School of Classical Studies in Athens.

ELIGIBILITY

The scholarship is open to any teacher of Classics at the pre-college level in Ohio (i.e. elementary, middle, or high-school level), who is currently a member of the OCC.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

The applicant must submit the following in order to be considered:

1. A completed application form (may be downloaded from OCC website)
2. A formal statement about how you feel this opportunity will be used to enhance your teaching.
3. Submit two letters of recommendation from administrators, department chairs, or colleagues familiar with you and your teaching.
4. Optional: recent transcripts of graduate work and/or any other information (e.g., awards won, areas of interest or research, academic credentials, etc.) which you feel support your (academic and professional) qualifications for this scholarship

DEADLINE FOR APPLICATION:

Applications must be received by November 15. Notification of the scholarship winner will be made by January 1st.
